- Ace Hardware-brand spray paint
- Krylon-brand spray paint

Both do an excellent job on plastic and will not peel for years to come.

Stop that Water Drop!

The barrels are Food Quality High Density Poly Ethylene Barrels that were previously used to ship pickled food overseas.

All barrels have a garden hose size spigot at the bottom, two overflow fittings, and a screw-on mesh lid to keep out debris and mosquitoes.

The SWCD is also selling additional accessories that will make for an easy installation.

Rain barrels are an excellent way to help the environment in urban areas because they reduce storm-water runoff which can carry pollutants and sediment directly to creeks and rivers.

The barrels will also save you money and precious groundwater supplies. The free stored rain water is naturally soft and free of chlorine which is great for use in gardens, houseplants, lawns and trees.

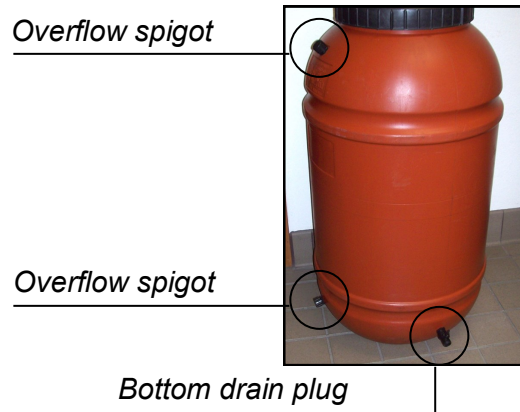


Rain barrel Components
